„Ovidius” University of Constanta (OUC) is the largest university in Europe to the Black Sea coast. Its location is in Constanta, the largest town in Dobroudgea, a Southeastern Romania blooming economic region, which is a cultural bridge between the West and the East, being also the European Union's Eastern gate.

The University was named after roman poet Publius Ovidius Naso, who lived the last part of its life in Tomis Constanta city prior Greek colony. He has left here a cultural heritage of all humankind, sending generations to come, through ancient Methamorphosys myths a message about passion and dedication, about the power of love, about creation, evolution and transformation.

A privileged location



Constanța Port is the largest European port to the Black Sea and one of the largest in the continent. The city is linked to our capital, Bucharest and the rest of the country through the A2 highway, to Europe by the Danube-Black Sea Channel, and also to the entire world through the „Mihail Kogălniceanu” International Airport.







„Ovidius” University of Constanta is a public institution of higher education founded in 1961, that became a multidisciplinary university in 1990, with programs for Bachelor, Master and Doctorate, a quality accreditation recognized by national and international institutions with high confidence.

The fields of education covered by its 16 faculties refers to economic sciences, arts, law and administrative sciences, mathematics and informatics, applied sciences, civil and mechanical engineering, theology, psychology and education sciences, history and political sciences, foreign languages, medicine and dentistry, pharmacy, agriculture and biology.

At the moment, OUC has 93 bachelor programs, 87 master programs, 7 doctoral schools and 38 post university programs.

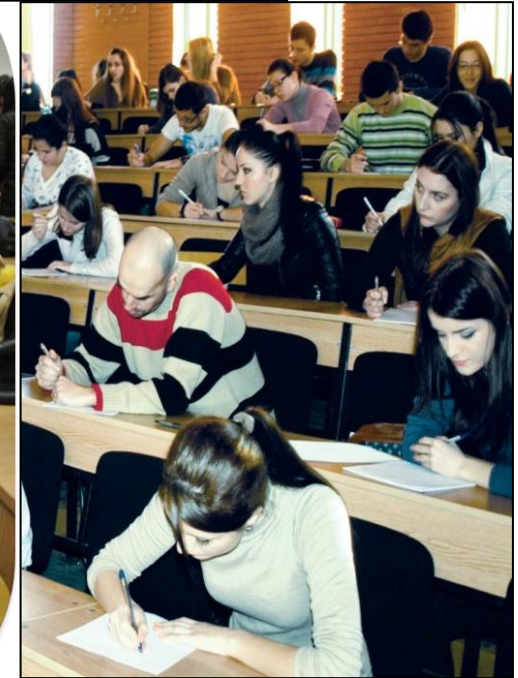

With almost 15.000 students and more than 1.000 academic and administrative staff, „**Ovidius**” **University of Constanta** is the largest institution of its kind in the Black Sea Area.

It has over 1.100 international students, of which about 28% of the EU states and the European Economic Area. The regions of origin are Europe (49% of students), Middle East (40%), Far East and Africa (5%).

Once implemented the Bologna process, starting with the 2005-2006 academic year, the OUC became part of the European Higher Education Area, offering diplomas recognized both in the EU and beyond. The supplements diplomas are bilingual, being written both in Romanian and in English.





„Ovidius” University's **mission** is to create, maintain and distribute knowledge to society through education, scientific research and artistic creation to European standards.

„Ovidius” University's **vision** is to be recognized as a regional leader in education and research, an Eastern gateway to Europe.

Its priorities are proven by a constant high ranking of the OUC among the universities focused on education and research. It also organizes annually more than 30 scientific and social events and most of them have an international dimension.

OUC is an active partner in the LLP ERASMUS study mobility program and in the ERASMUS+ Program, organizing mobilities for more than 50 students and 20 teaching and administrative staff.

The infrastructure



The infrastructure of the “Ovidius” University of Constanta is performant, the university has modern education spaces, equipped for the didactic process in professional conditions.

The useful area for teaching activities (classrooms, seminar rooms, laboratories, and reading rooms) is over 24,000 sqm.

The University has an e-learning platform. It was originally developed for students of distance learning forms, but can be used for different educational activities. The existence of this IT platform has given teachers the opportunity to develop theoretical and practical online courses, which has the same values as lessons taught in classrooms.



Projects



Since 2011, Ovidius University of Constanta (UOC) through Civil Engineering Faculty and Faculty of Maritime, Industrial and Mechanical Engineering, develop different activities for and with young people. “Civil Engineering profession- between present and future” (funded by UOC), TEHNONAV-Junior (funded by UOC and National Education Ministry), are some projects that these faculties have developed.

The aim of these educational projects is to provide to the youth people (students in high school between 15-18 years old) with the necessary digital tools to develop skills and abilities to be self-dependent, employable, active and competitive.

Projects



The TRAIN-RES project (funded by the Programme LIFELONG LEARNING, Subprogramme LEONARDO DA VINCI,) was created for adults, but it also provided the opportunity for teachers to improve their skills in developing on-line training courses.

The educational package with technical and methodological content is available on intranet in Romanian, English and Turkish language.
